

JOB DESCRIPTION

- Position:** Youth (Female) Competitions Chair
- Method of Selection:** *Appointed by the Regional President
*appointments are ratified by the membership at the AGM
- Term of Office:** One year

Job Description:

The Regional Youth (Female) Competitions Chair is the direct link between the girls' teams in their respective region and the Provincial Competitions Committee. Where applicable, the Chair shall direct the planning, implementation and delivery of the youth competitions program for girls within the region, as per the goals and priorities of the region. The Chair will oversee the operation of female youth leagues and/or tournaments within the region, as required.

The Youth (Female) Competitions Chair serves as a member of the Provincial Youth (Female) Competitions Committee.

Duties:

- 1) Attend OVA Provincial Competitions Committee meetings for the Youth Female Program
 - a. Liaise with Coaches and Athletes of Youth (Female) Teams in the region
 - b. Serve as the communication link between these teams in the region and the provincial level
 - c. Represent the needs, wishes and interests of the teams from their respective region
 - d. Gather information regarding changes in future formats for dissemination in the region
- 2) Liaise with the Provincial Chair as required
- 3) Attend Regional Management Committee Meetings
- 4) Coordinate Regional Competitions as per the goals and priorities of the region
- 5) Implement the steps necessary to ensure that the OVA Risk Management guidelines are known by coaches and teams, and are adhered to for all OVA Sanctioned Youth Female Competitions within the region.
- 6) Act as an ambassador for the Ontario Volleyball Association within the region
